

## SPEARWOOD PRIMARY SCHOOL Internet Policy

## Rationale

Spearwood Primary School recognises that student and staff access to the Internet is a valuable resource in the location and manipulation of information.

## **Policy**

- 1. Spearwood Primary School understands its responsibilities for appropriate usage of the Internet and email facilities.
- 2. Students access the Internet and use email facilities, under teacher supervision.
- 3. Students will complete a 'Student Internet Access Contract' including parent permission, before accessing the Internet.

## **Operational Guidlines**

- 1. The Internet is to be used to access appropriate curriculum related materials for classroom and school purposes.
- 2. Students agree to access only those sites that they are willing to share with their parents and teachers.
- 3. If an inappropriate site is accessed accidentally, students will immediately turn off the monitor and notify an adult.
- 4. Students will not give out personal details such as family names, addresses or phone numbers of themselves or others, whilst using the Internet or email.
- 5. If students deliberately breach their contract, then, following consultation with the child's parent, the school may withdraw their Internet access for a period up a term (10 weeks) as determined by the Principal.
